PREFACE

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ABSTRACT

This is the 11th volume in the series of scientific reports produced by the International Centre for Diarrhoeal Disease Research, Bangladesh (former Cholera Research Laboratory), presenting basic tabulations from the registration of births, deaths, marriages, divorces and migrations in the Demographic Surveillance System of the Matlab Field Station. The present volume presents results as obtained from the surveillance area for the calendar year 1981.

INTRODUCTION

The present volume reports the results obtained from the Demographic Surveillance System (DSS), Matlab in the calendar year 1981 (Figure 1 and 2 for location of Matlab and DSS area). In Volume One of this series, a detailed description of the DSS and its operation is given. From 1978, however, some modifications in the DSS have been introduced, in terms of area-coverage and field operation. These changes were described in detail in Volume Seven of this series. This volume's reporting format, in terms of tabulation pattern and presentation, essentially is the same as that followed in the preceding Volume 10 (for the year 1980). To make the tables self-explanatory, a few explanations and notes are provided below:

NOTES FOR TABLE

Table I

The Demographic Surveillance System (DSS) area of Matlab consists of 149 villages (see Figure 2, and Appendix A for village location and names). The mid-year population of this area refers to the date July 1, 1981, and has been obtained through computer updating of the census population (as of December 31, 1978) for all registered births, deaths and migrations (in/out) which occurred from January 1, 1979 to June 30, 1981.

Age is recorded in total completed years as of last birthday. For persons who were born within the DSS area after 1966, age figures are exact. In cases where ages are unknown -- which may apply to in-migrants or to persons born before 1966 -- ascertainment of age is made as accurately as possible, by reference to any past event that may be remembered.

Table II

The 1981 crude death rates in the DSS area and in its two components, the MCH-FP and comparison areas, do not change substantially when compared with those of the preceding year. In contrast, the infant mortality rate (deaths per 1,000 live births) rose from 103.9 in 1980 to 109.1 in 1981. The reported increase (from 91.9 to 102.6) is registered in the MCH-FP area, while in the comparison area infant mortality remains almost at the constant level of 114. While this increase may have occurred, problems related to the reporting of male infant deaths in 1980 could be a contributory factor, (cf. Vol. 10, p.5).

Table IV

The sex-wise pattern of infant mortality in 1981 differs from that of 1980, but is similar to previous years. For males, infant mortality rose from 90.2 in 1980 to 104.8 in 1981, whereas for females it decreased from

MAP OF BANGLADESH SHOWING THE STUDY AREA

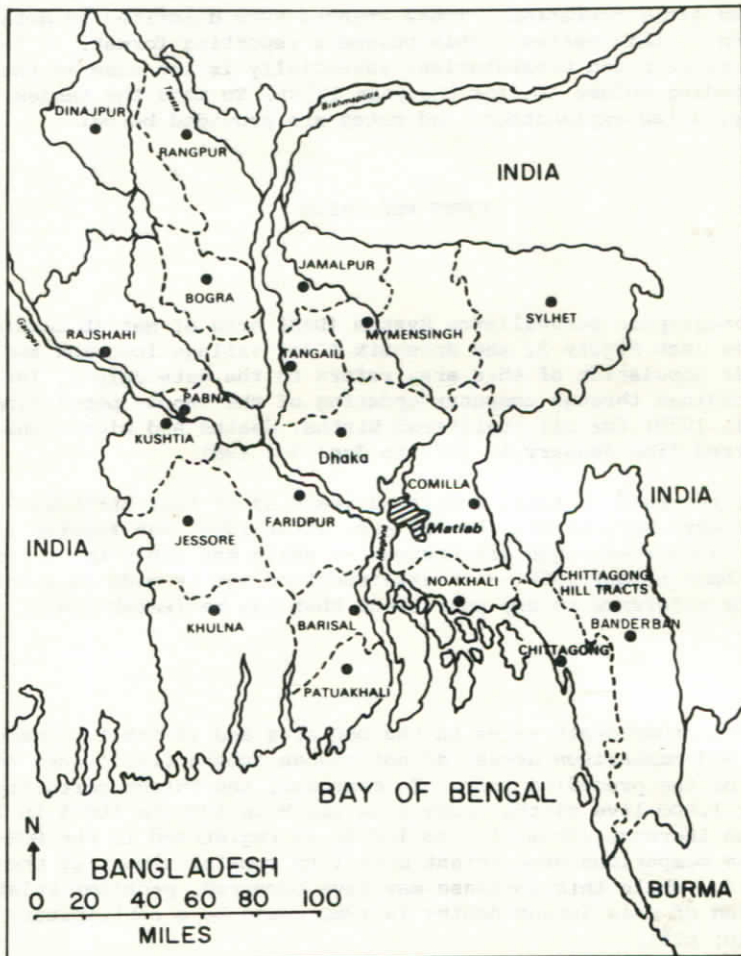
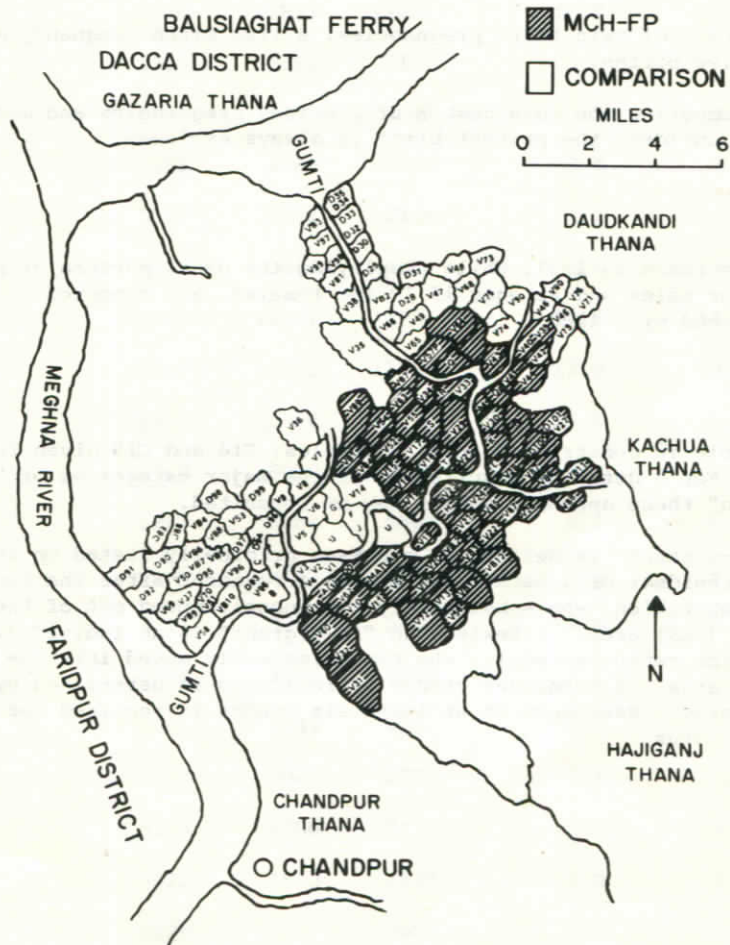
Key:  study areas

118.5 to 113.7. These reported mortality shifts apply both for the neonatal and post-neonatal stages. These results too indicate a possible under-reporting of male infant deaths in 1980.

Tables VII & IX

A pregnancy outcome is designated as "early miscarriage" if the gestation period is less than seven months. For gestation beyond seven months, foetal loss is said to be a "stillbirth."

In the case of twin birth pregnancies, a live birth pregnancy may have one or two live births.

While computing the mean number of previous pregnancies and mean number of surviving children the present birth is always excluded.

Table X

Marriage rates in 1981, while displaying the usual pattern of peaks at ages 25-29 for males and at ages 15-19 for females, are reported to be 10% higher, compared with 1980.

Table XIV

This table is constructed from two tables, C14 and C15 given in Appendix C. For a detailed description of the major categories of "reasons for migration" these appendix tables may be consulted.

An "out-migrant" is defined as a person originally listed on the census record as a resident or a person who became a resident after the census by birth or in-migration, who subsequently permanently moved out of the surveillance (DSS) area. Likewise, an "in-migrant" is an individual not recorded in the census schedule, who has permanently moved into the surveillance area. A permanent change of residence is determined by the duration of stay. Residence of at least six months is required for "permanent" status.

Fig. 3: AGE PYRAMID OF THE 1981 MID YEAR POPULATION

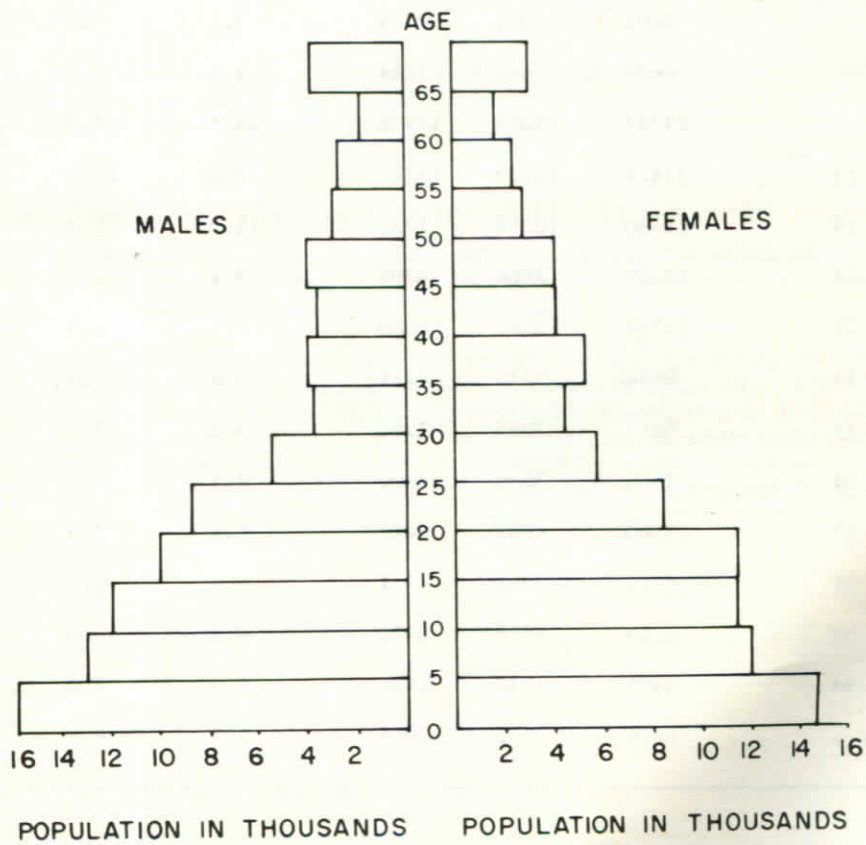

IN 1981

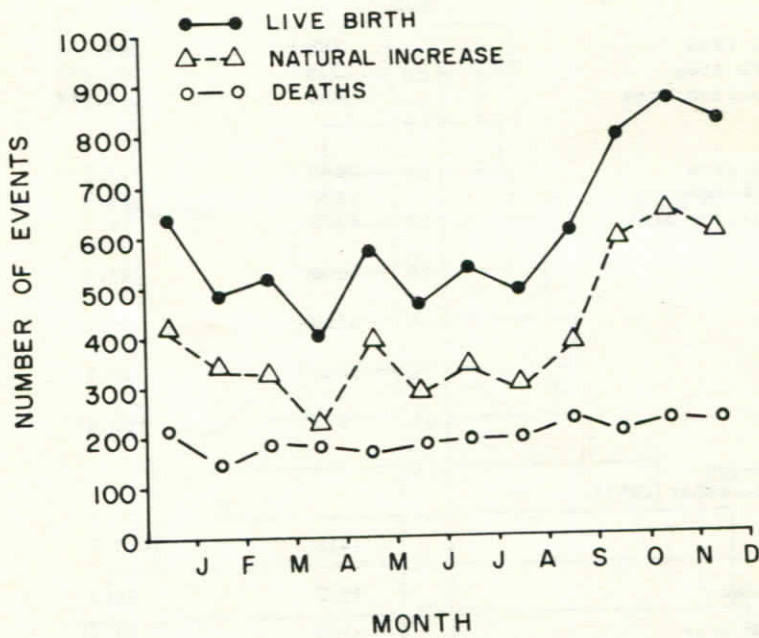

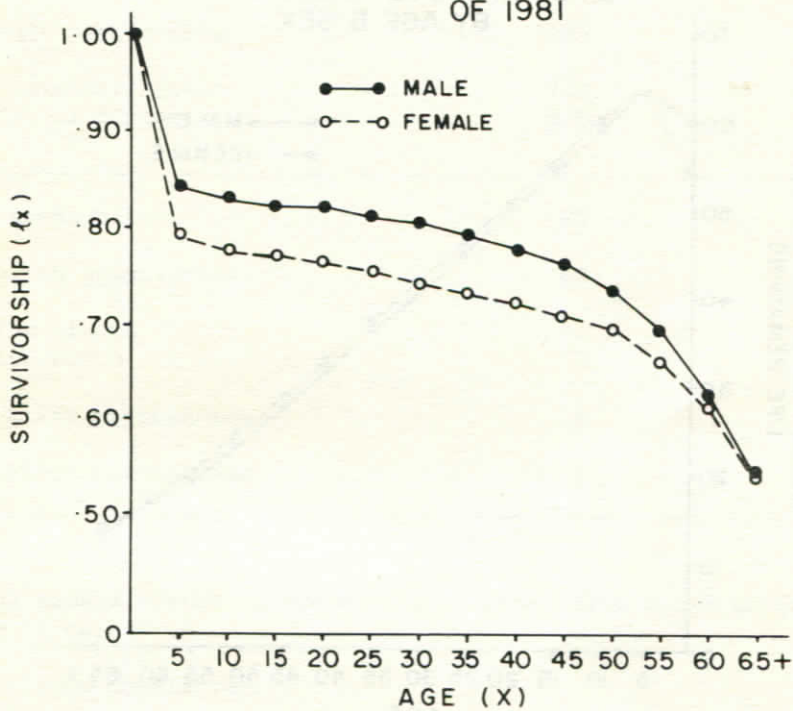


Fig. 6: EXPECTATION OF YEARS OF REMAINING

BY AGE & SEX

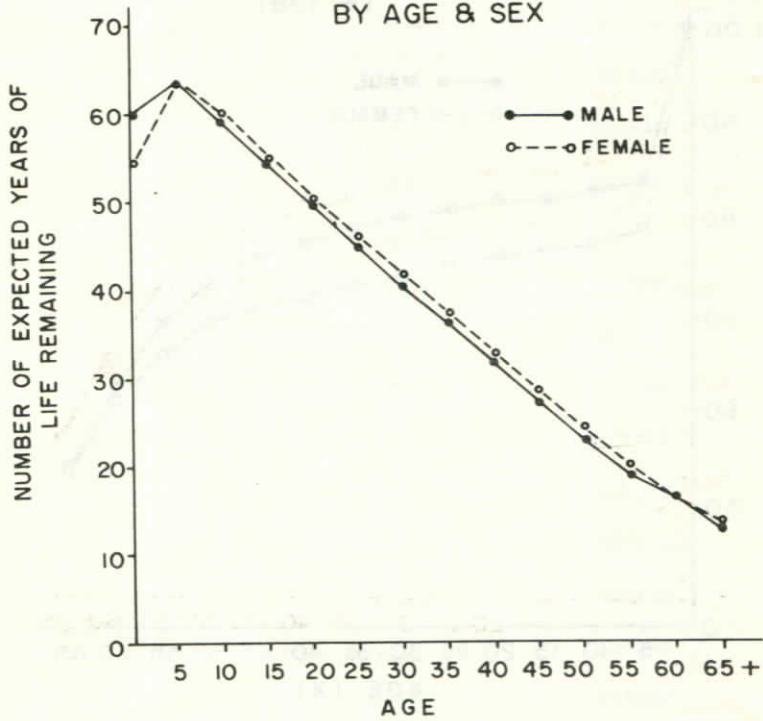

IN 1981 BY AGE

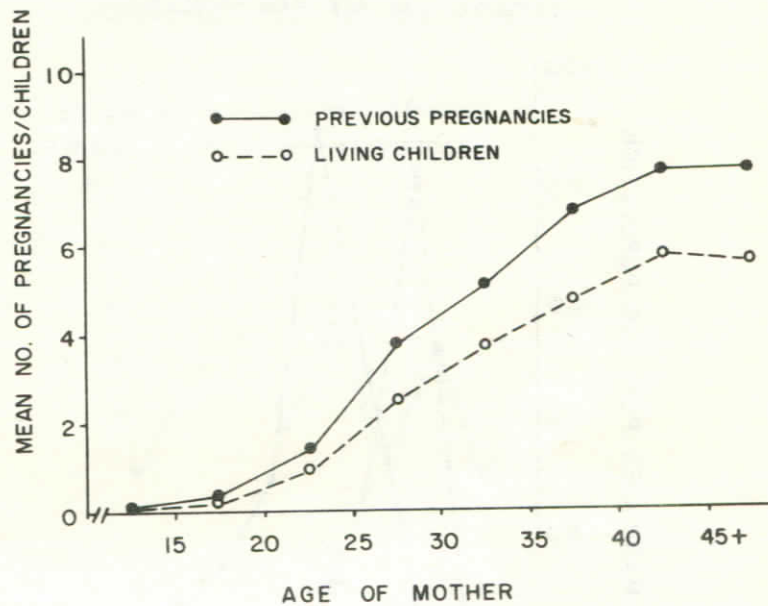


Fig. 9: MARRIAGE RATES IN 1981
BY AGE AND SEX

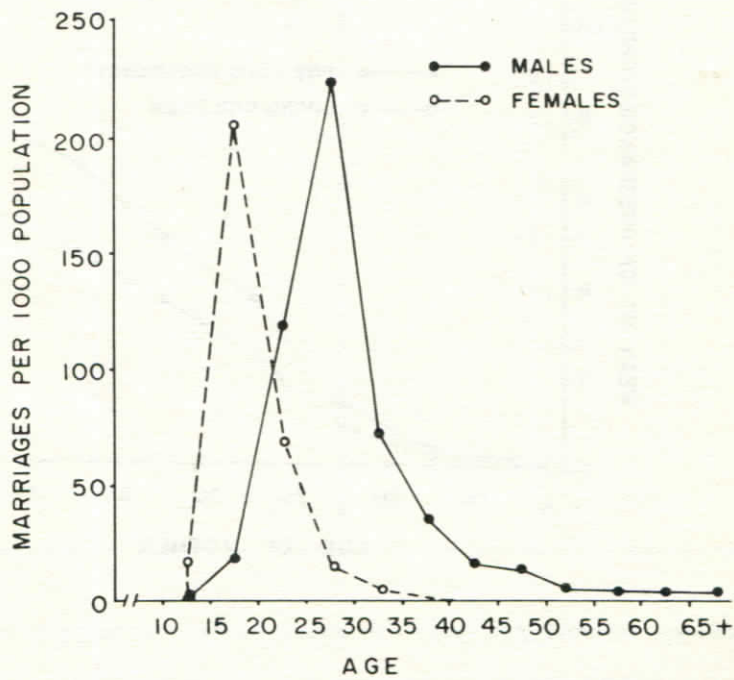


Fig. 10: NUMBER OF MARRIAGES AND DIVORCES
REGISTERED IN 1981 BY MONTH

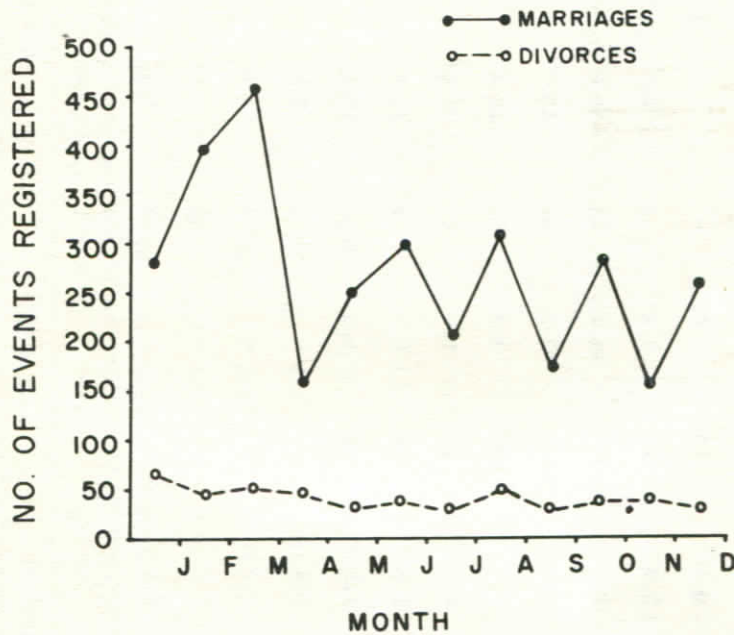

Fig. 11: NUMBER OF IN AND OUT MIGRATIONS OF MALES AND FEMALES REGISTERED IN 1981 BY MONTH

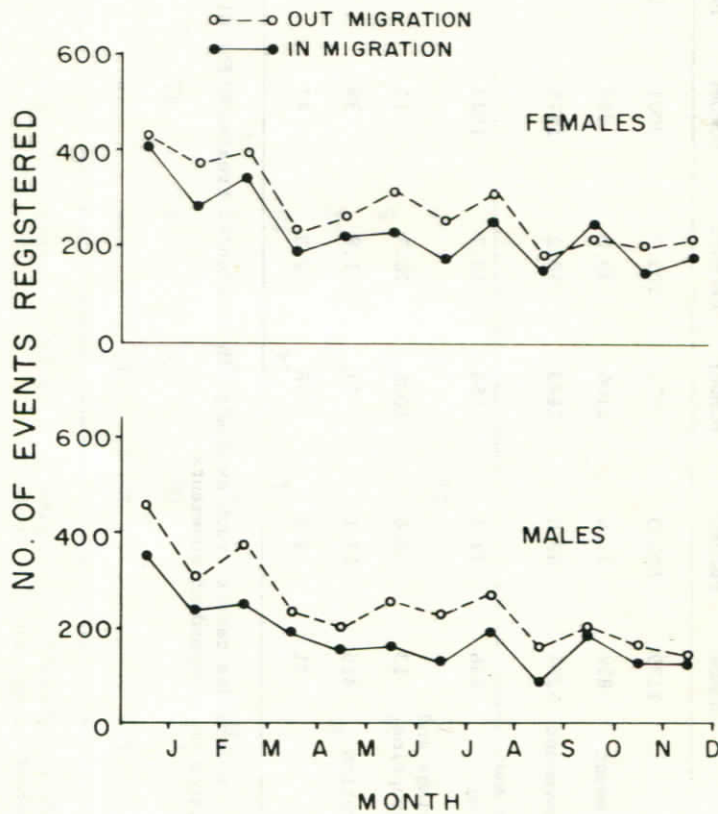

Fig.12: MALE AND FEMALE MIGRATION RATES IN 1981 BY AGE AND DIRECTION

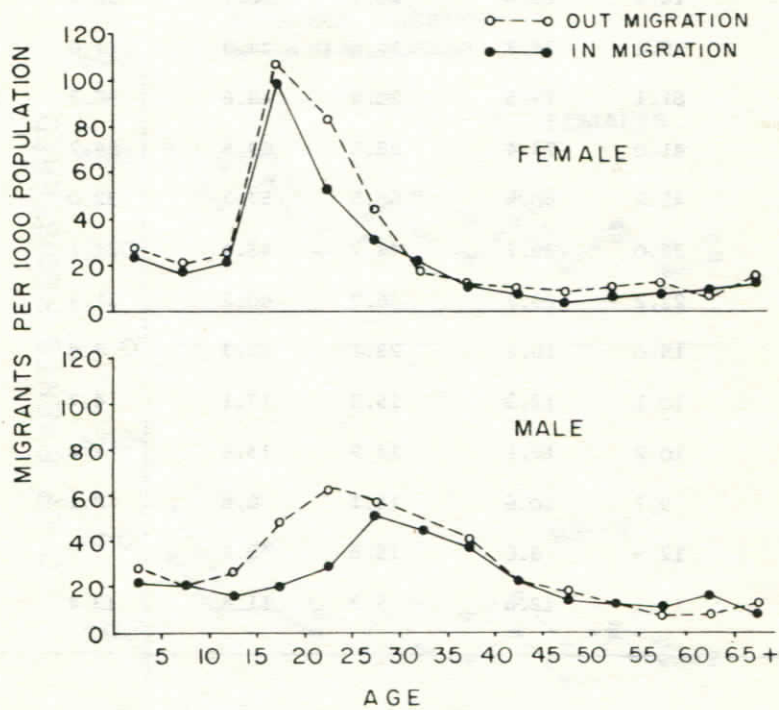

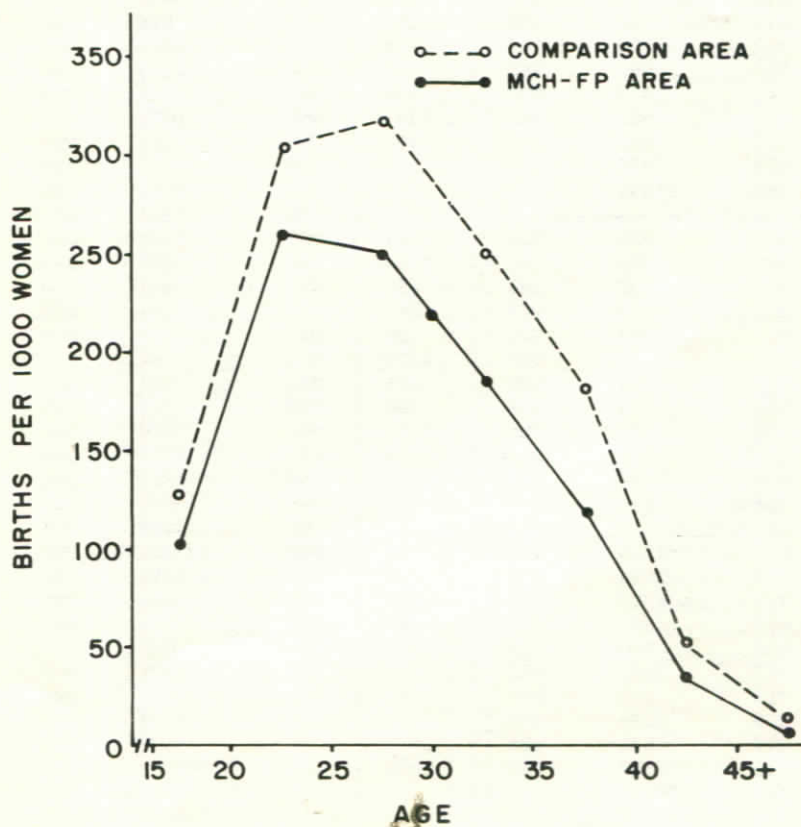
