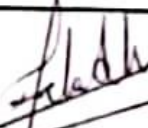

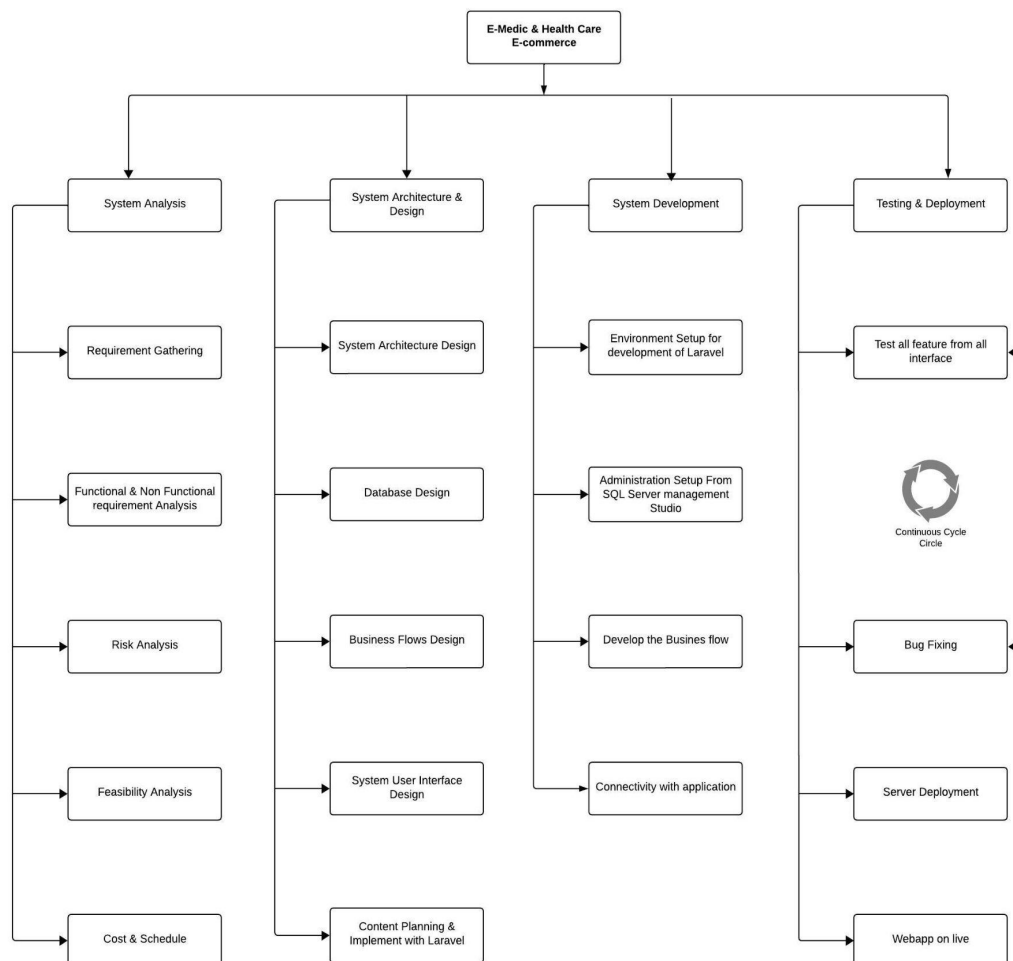


Figure 3.1 Work Breakdown Structure

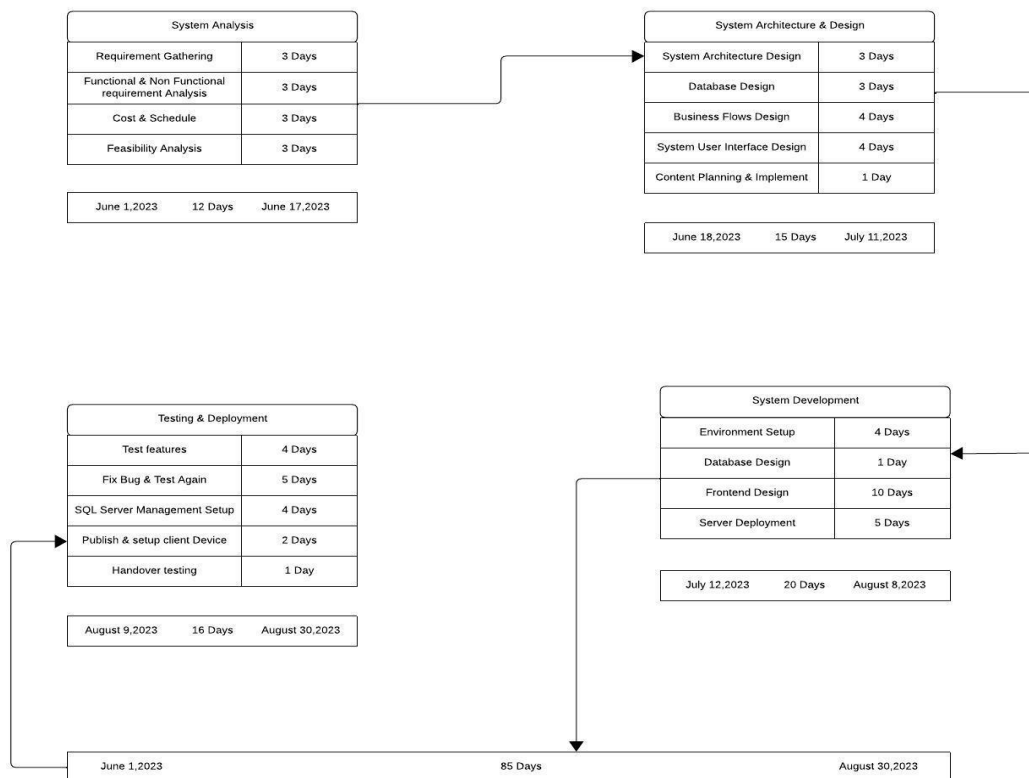


Figure 3. 2 Time Distribution

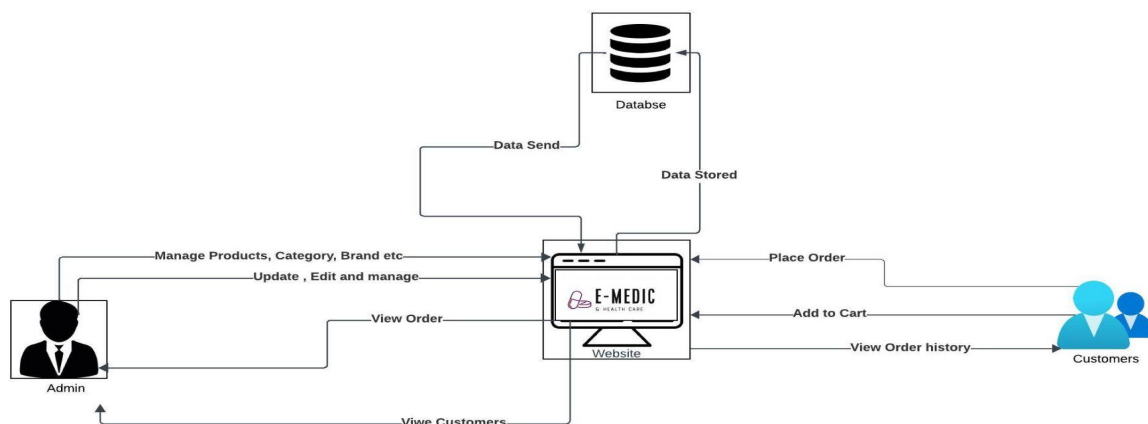


Figure 5. 1 : Rich Picture

Entity Relation Diagram for E-Medic & Health Care

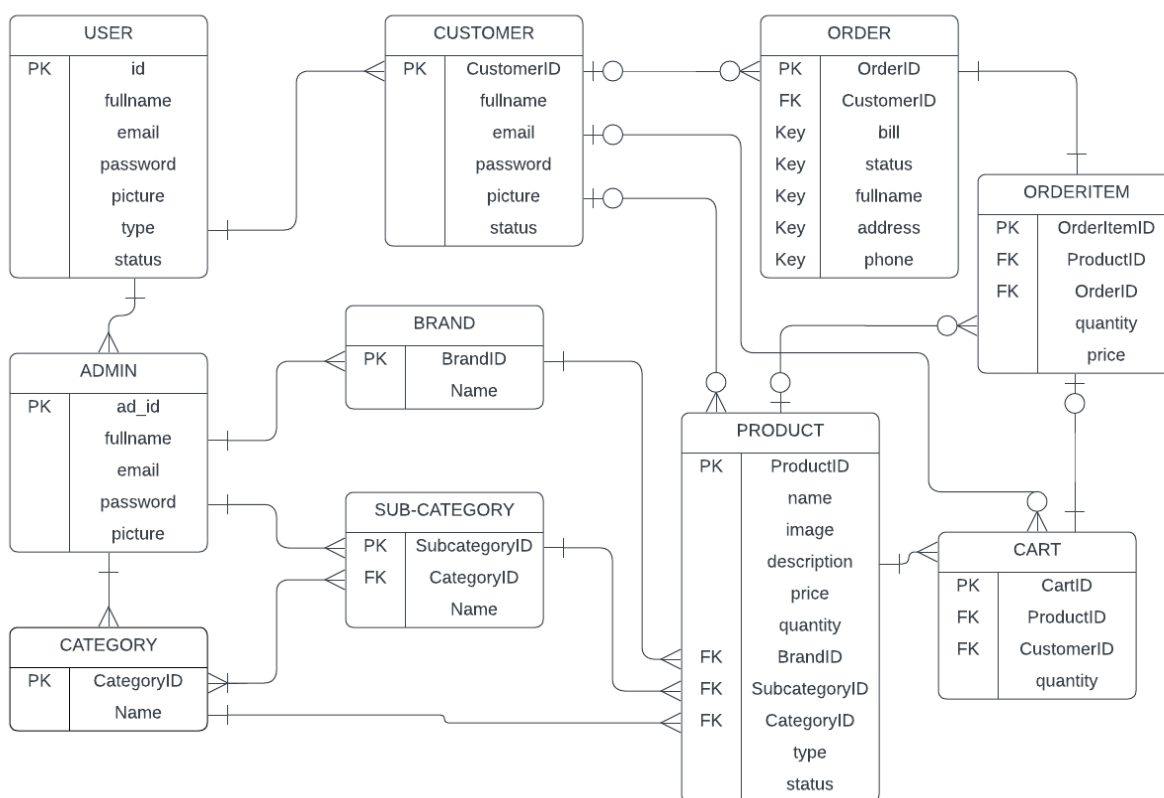


Figure 5. 2 : Entity Relationship Diagram

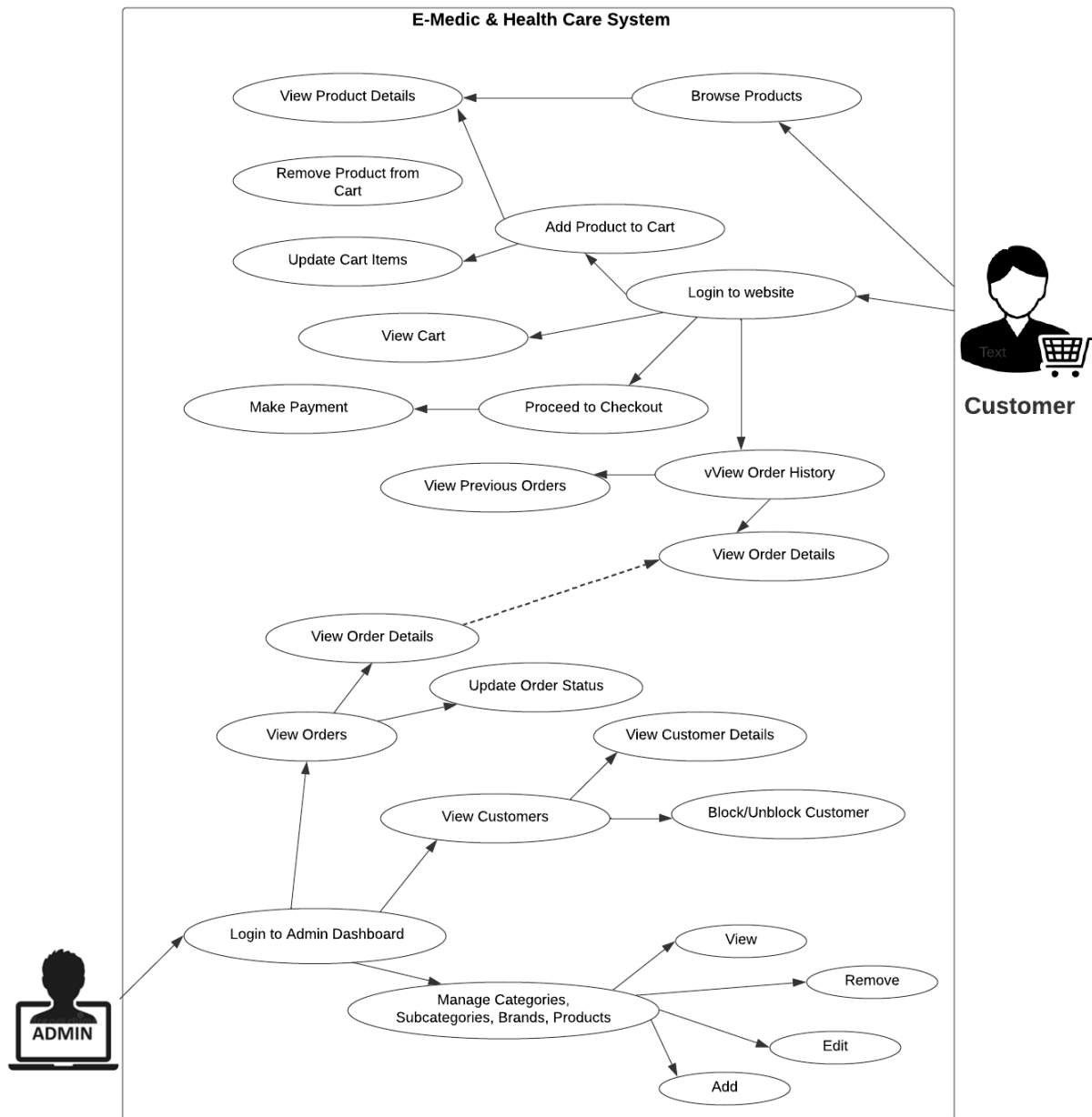


Figure 5. 3 : Use Case Diagram FOR Admin & Customer

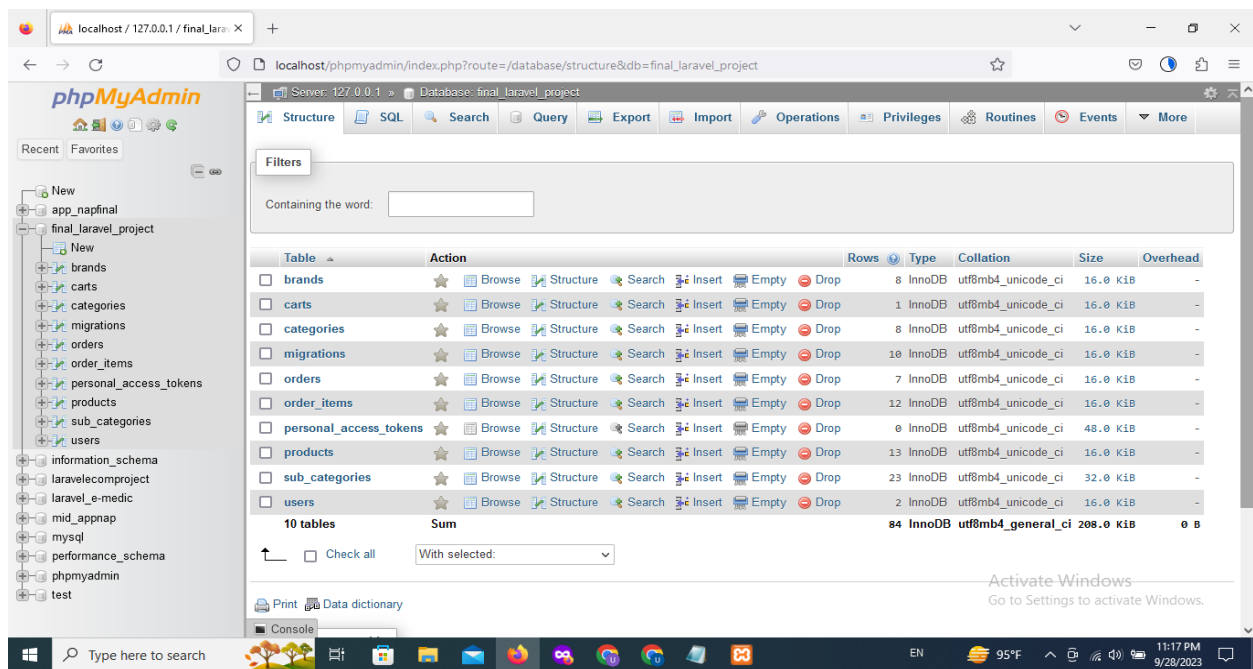


Figure 5.4: Database screenshot

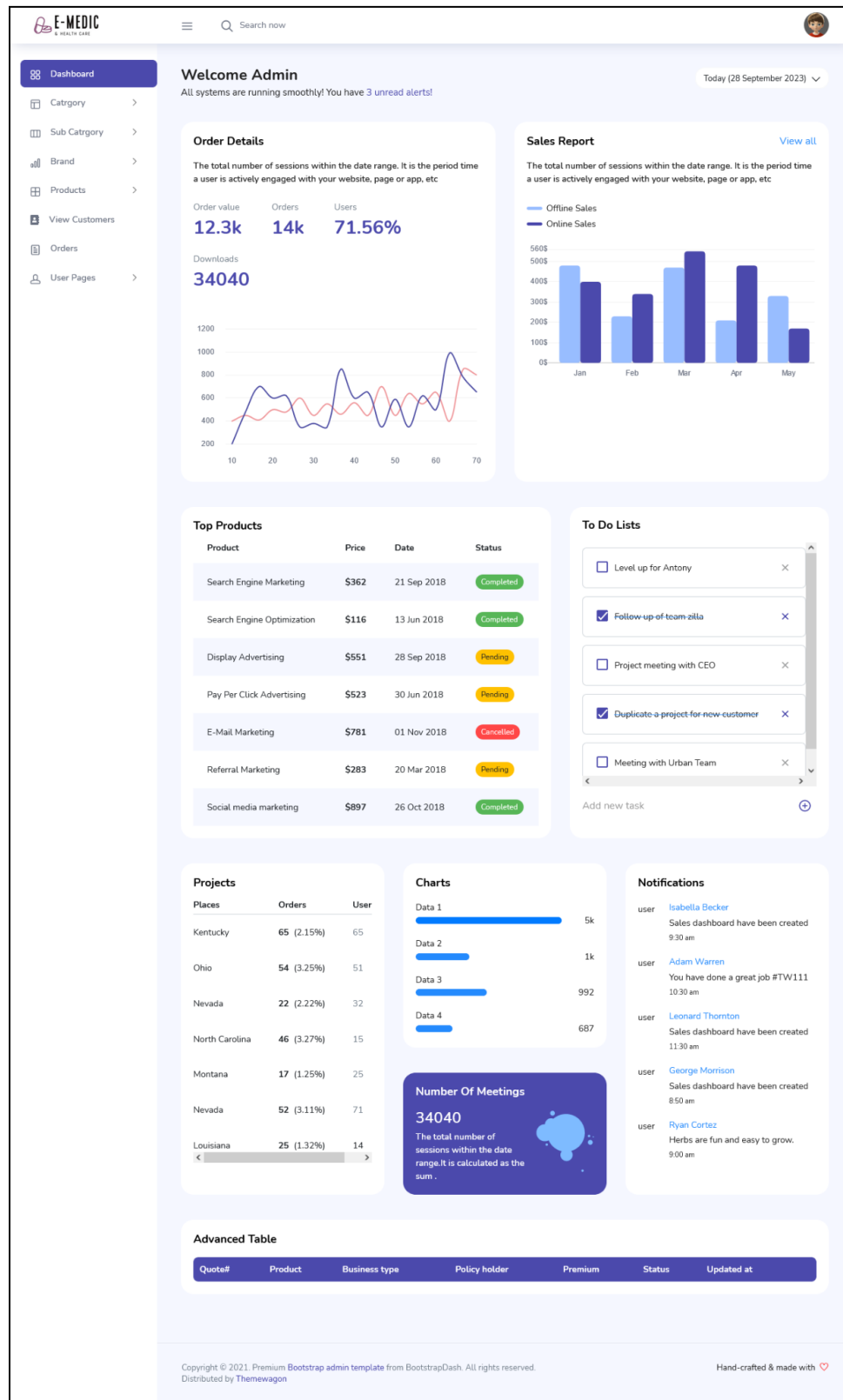


Figure 5.6 : General Page screenshot

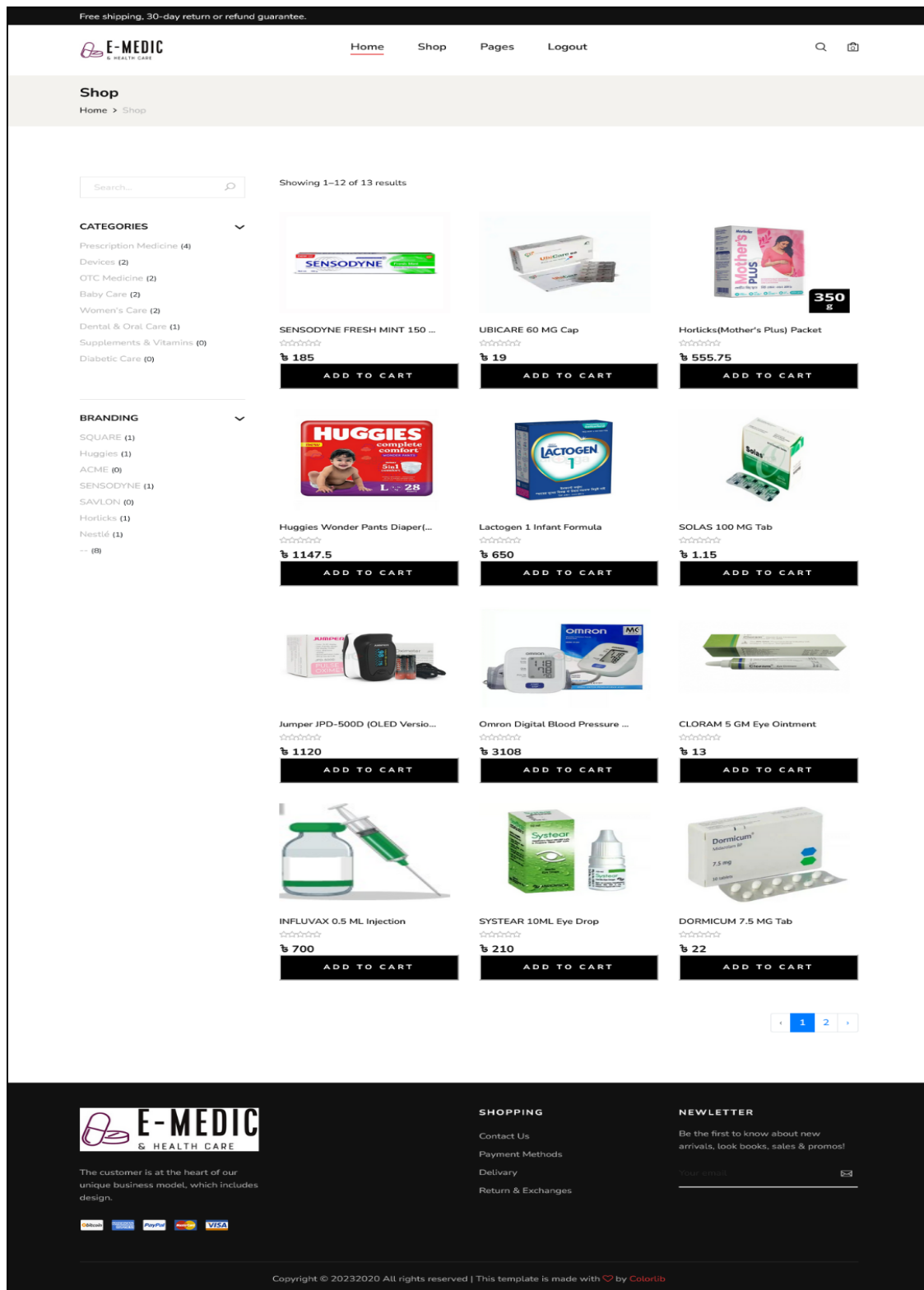


Figure 5.7 : Customer Side screenshot
