Profile of the Convocation Speaker

Asian Institute of Technology President, July 2005 - Present

Professor Said Irandoust, a Swedish national, currently serves as the President of the Asian Institute of Technology (AIT), which is based in Thailand with affiliated Centers in Vietnam and Indonesia. Professor Irandoust was born in 1960 in Tabriz in the province of Azerbaijan in north-west Iran. He moved to Sweden in 1979 as an exchange student. Professor Said Irandoust gained a M.Sc. in Eng. degree in chemical engineering at Chalmers in 1984 and a PhD in 1989 with a thesis on monolith reactors.

Prior to joining AIT he was the Vice Chancellor of the University of Borås, Sweden from 2001-2005. Development of strong research environments, internationalization, partnership, with stakeholders and development of a new university concept "The first Swedish University of Professions" were among the key projects during his presidency. Before that he worked with one of Sweden's leading universities Chalmers from 1990 to 2000, with his last position being that of Vice President.

As the Vice President at Chalmers, he initiated and supervised a number of development projects within higher learning, further education for professionals, and internationalization. He was Chair of the Swedish Government's Committee for promoting mathematics and member of the Swedish Government's Committee for widening recruitment to universities. He served as a Member of the Board of the National Museums of World Culture, Sweden. He also served as a Member of the Board of Engineers Without Borders and of the Board of the Swedish Foundation for Internationalization of Research and Higher Education (STINT).

Professor Irandoust has received the Medal of Progress from the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan. He is also the recipient of an Honorary Doctorate from the Plekhanov Russian Academy of Economics in Moscow.

Let me begin by extending my wholehearted congratulations and my very best wishes to the graduates. Your preparation for the real world is not in the answers you have learned, but in the questions you have learned how to ask yourself.

Here I would like to narrate the story of the pencil by Paulo Coelho. I find it very relevant and one that carries a profound message to all of us, especially to you our graduates. A boy was watching his grandmother write a letter. At one point he asked: 'Are you writing a story about what we've done? Is it a story about me?'

His grandmother stopped writing her letter and said to her grandson: 'I am writing about you, actually, but more important than the words is the pencil I'm using. I hope you will be like this pencil when you grow up.'

Intrigued, the boy looked at the pencil. It didn't seem very special. 'But it's just like any other pencil I've ever seen!'

'That depends on how you look at things. It has five qualities which, if you manage to hang on them, will make you a person who is always at peace with the world.'

'First quality: you are capable of great things, but you must never forget that there is a hand guiding your steps. We call that hand God, and He always guides us according to His will.'

'Second quality: now and then, I have to stop writing and use a sharpener. That makes the pencil suffer a little, but afterwards, he's much sharper. So you, too, must learn to bear certain pains and sorrows, because they will make you a better person.'

'Third quality: the pencil always allows us to use an eraser to rub out any mistakes. This means that correcting something we did is not necessarily a bad thing; it helps to keep us on the road to justice.'

'Fourth quality: what really matters in a pencil is not its wooden exterior, but the graphite inside. So always pay attention to what is happening inside you.'

'Finally, the pencil's fifth quality: it always leaves a mark. In just the same way, you should know that everything you do in life will leave a mark, so try to be conscious of that in your every action'.

I also narrated this story at one of AIT's graduation ceremonies and the former Prime Minister of Thailand H.E. Mr. Anand Panyarachun, who was the former Chairman of the AIT Board of Trustees, also added another quality or unique attribute of the pencil. He stated that the pencil is always "straight" which I found very meaningful and implies the importance or virtue of demonstrating integrity and honesty at all times.

As you face the future, some of you may be concerned about the many seemingly insurmountable challenges that lie ahead for your generation. I am fully confident that each of you in one way or the other will do your part by helping contribute to the betterment of your communities, societies, regions and world. It has been said that brilliant opportunities are often cleverly disguised as difficult challenges problems. The challenges we all face, the difficult problems that present themselves in the future are, I believe, these brilliant opportunities you have prepared yourselves to encounter.

In one of his articles, psychiatrist and former instructor at the Harvard Medical School Dr. Edward Hallowell writes that it is important to spend as much time as one can at the intersection of three spheres: what you are good at, what you like to do and what adds value to the world. At the intersection of those spheres lies a land of joy and productivity that can successfully compete with the force of entropy, of disorder, that tilts us all toward lassitude.

Therefore, I hope that your future endeavors will resonate with commitment to developing yourselves further in every respect as a person, to making the quality of lives of your people and of the world, better, and to helping people less fortunate than yourselves to realize their potential. It is for these worthy purposes for which you have been prepared and equipped.

Congratulations to each one of you once again, not only for your accomplishments, but also for the enormous promise your future holds.

In concluding, I also wish Eastern University all the best and many more successes in its important role of human resources development in Bangladesh and beyond.

Eastern University - A Brief Profile

Eastern University was established in 2003 under the Private University Act 1992, as amended in 1998. The University was set up by Eastern University Foundation - a non-profit, non-political and philanthropic organization. Its founders include academics, chartered accountants, engineers, industrialists and retired civil servants. At present, the Foundation has 30 members. The governance of Eastern University is carried out as per the Private Universities Act of 2010.

Vision

The vision of Eastern University is to become a leading University in South Asia in its chosen fields of higher education.

Mission

Its mission is to be a "Center of Excellence" by setting a new standard of quality teaching and quality education in Bangladesh, keeping in view the challenges of the 21st century.

Goal

Its goal is to produce future leaders with knowledge and skills essential for leadership in country's private and public sector enterprises in the increasingly competitive and globalized environment.

Faculties and Departments

The University currently has four Faculties: Faculty of Arts, Faculty of Business Administration, Faculty of Engineering and Technology and Faculty of Law. The Faculty of Arts has two departments: Department of English and Department of Applied Linguistics and ELT (English Language Teaching). The Faculty of Business Administration is a single Department Faculty but has four major areas, namely Accounting, Finance, Marketing, Management and Human Resource. A few social science courses are also offered by this Faculty. The Faculty of Engineering and Technology has two departments: Department of Computer Science and Information Technology and Department of Electrical and Electronics Engineering. The Faculty of Law is again a single Department Faculty having undergraduate and postgraduate programmes.

Curriculum

Eastern University follows North American model of curriculum in the fields of Business Administration, Computer Science and Electrical and Electronics Engineering; the UK model in Law and English. The academic programme is pursued through a framework of curriculum that includes splitting up of an academic year into three semesters: the Fall, the Spring and the Summer. The Curricula of the academic programmes are of international standard and are updated regularly to make it relevant to future job requirements of the students.

Teaching Philosophy and Methods

The Eastern University's objective is to raise a knowledgeable, skillful, conscientious and committed young work force who will be able to assume leadership role in whatever situation they are likely to find themselves in the real world. It aims at instilling in students a perennial hunger for knowledge and quest for application of knowledge. For achieving this objective, carefully prepared classroom lectures are followed by tutorial classes and practical sessions aimed at enhancing students' problem solving skill, presentation skill and leadership qualities. A personalized attention is given to every student to search out the latent faculties and then effort is made to bring out the best from him/her.

Structure of Eastern University Governance

Although basically a private sector institution like other private Universities, governance of Eastern University is conducted on the basis of wide consensus of several statutory bodies and committees which have recently been restructured according to the Private University Act of 2010. They are:

Students

The students admitted to Eastern University come with good academic background. More than 8500 students have been admitted till Summer 2010 since the beginning of the University. Out of these, about 1200 have graduated. Other students are at various stages of their study.

Admission Schedule

Eastern University admits students every semester. Admission schedule of the semester is available on the web site of the University. The admission schedule may also be known from the Admission Office and from frequent admission announcements published by the University in the leading news papers. The students seeking admission should visit web site of Eastern University or contact the Admission Office for admission form and further information.

Admission Requirements for Undergraduate Programmes

Candidates with a minimum GPA of 2.50 separately in both SSC/Dakhil and HSC/Alim/Diploma from Technical Education Board or a minimum GPA of 2.00 in one of those exams with a total GPA of 6.00 in both the exams are eligible for admission. The GCE students must have passed five subjects in O-level and two subjects in A-level.

Admission Requirements for Graduate Programmes

Students must have at least second division or GPA of 2.50 separately in SSC and HSC exams or a minimum GPA of 2.00 in one of those exams with a total GPA of 6.00 in both the exams or have passed at least five subjects in O-Level and two subjects in A-Level. They must have minimum second class or GPA of 2.50 at Bachelor Level. Executive MBA programme requires in addition at least 2 years of job experience.

Faculty Members

Eastern University hires top-of-the class, talented graduates as junior faculty, experienced teachers and researchers as senior faculty and professionally accomplished teachers and experts as adjunct faculty. As of Fall 2010, the University has 132 fulltime faculty members including 5 visiting professors from the USA. In addition, there are 55 adjunct faculty members.

Campus

The University campus consists of six large and spacious buildings - all located in the prime area of Dhanmondi, and easily accessible from any part of Dhaka City and outskirts by public transportation as well as auto-rickshaw and rickshaw. The required amount of land that is needed to be purchased for its permanent campus has also been finalized by the Board of Governors, Eastern University.

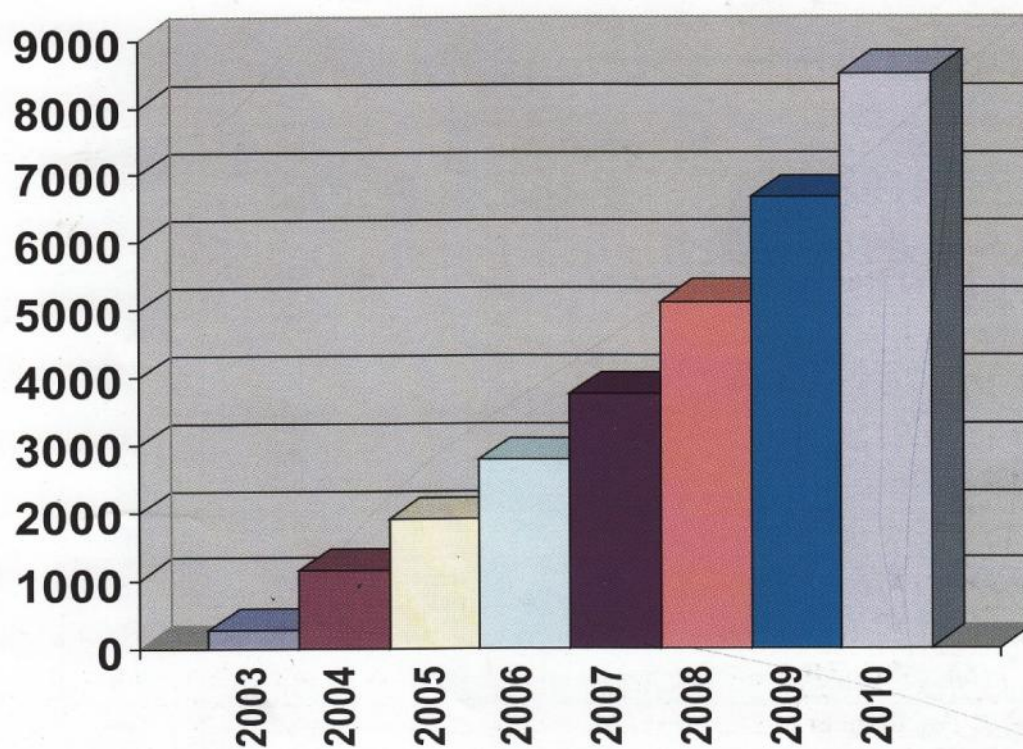

Faculty of Arts

The Faculty of Arts was one of the four Faculties with which Eastern University started in Summer 2003. The Faculty initially began with only M.A. ELT (English Language Teaching) program, and then added B.A. (Hons.) in English one Semester after the start of the University. The Faculty now has two full-fledged Departments: (i) Department of English and (ii) Department of Applied Linguistics and ELT. The Department of English has two programs: (i) a four-year B.A. (Hons.) in English and a one-year M.A. ELL (English Language and Literature). The Department of Applied Linguistics and ELT offers one-year M.A. ELT and two-year M.A. ELT.

A good degree in English can open a window of opportunities at home and abroad. Graduates in English are preferred for jobs ranging from Teaching to Media, Banks, Multinational Companies. English graduates are likely to do best at BCS Exams. English graduates also find it easy to pursue MBA; the combination is best for top corporate jobs.

The English Program at Eastern follows needs-based multi syllabus approach combining well-balanced language and literature courses in order to cater to above job needs.

The Faculty of Arts is headed by Professor Dr. Nurul Islam who taught English at King Soud University for a decade. He has also taught at Michigan State University as a Fulbright Scholar. With him there are 20 highly qualified and highly motivated full-time teachers some of whom with degrees and training from abroad. Besides, some very senior and nationally renowned academics from Dhaka University and Jahangirnagar University teach at Eastern as part-time faculties.

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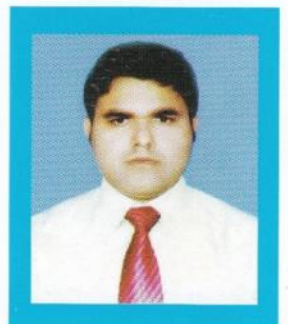

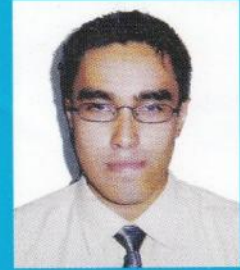

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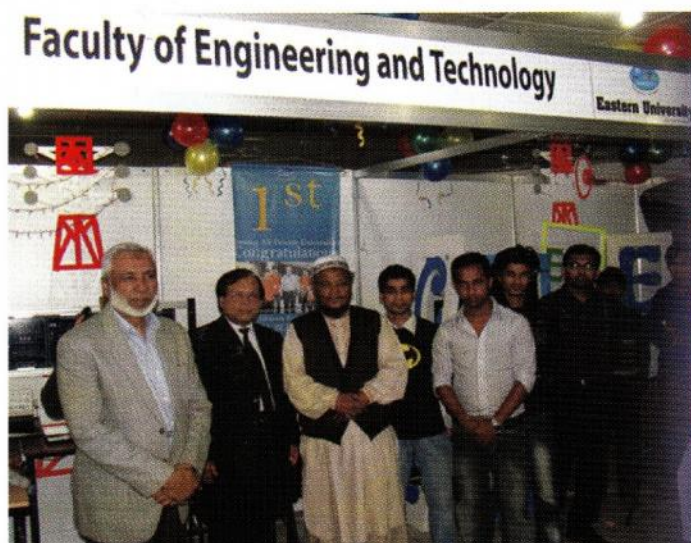

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Faculty of Engineering & Technology

The Faculty of Engineering and Technology is the second largest faculty of university in terms of number of students. At present, it has two departments: Department of Computer Science and Information Technology and Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering.

Department of Computer Science and Information Technology

The Department of Computer Science and Information Technology offers programs leading to the degrees of B.Sc. in CSE (Computer Science and Engineering), B.Sc. in CSIS (Computer Science and Information Systems) and M.Sc. in CSE (Computer Science and Engineering). The duration of B.Sc. in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) is four years divided into 12 semesters. To obtain the degree students are required to complete 157 credit hours with a minimum CGPA of 2.50.

Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering

The Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering offers program leading to the degree of B. Sc. in Electrical and Electronic Engineering [BSc(EEE)]. The total credit hours for completion of the B.Sc. (EEE) program is 149. The program includes courses from (1) general areas namely, English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Arts, Social sciences, Accounting, and from (2) Engineering disciplines namely, Electrical and Electronic Engineering as major area, and Mechanical Engineering. The program requires some of the courses as core courses and students have option to choose a few courses as elective for specialization. The curriculum for the BSc(EEE) has been designed to make the program goal-oriented to fulfill the needs of the age. The Department offers the program in both day and evening sections. The day section is for HSC or A level passed full time students. The evening section is for part time students of Diploma holders in Engineering who get 17 credit hours exemption based on their performance in the Diploma.

The Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering offers program leading to the degree of B.Sc. in Electronic and Telecommunication Engineering [B.Sc. (ETE)]. The total credit hours for completion of the B.Sc. (ETE) program is 155. The program includes courses from (1) general areas, namely English, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Arts, Social Sciences, Accounting, and from (2) Engineering disciplines, namely Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering as major area, and Electrical Engineering. The program requires some of the courses as core courses and students have option to choose a few courses as elective for specialization. The curriculum for the B.Sc. (ETE) has been designed to make the program goal-oriented to fulfill the needs of the age. The Department offers the program in both day and evening sections. The day section is for HSC or A level passed full time students.
